DOROMB' (MOUTH HARP) WORKSHOP IN THE VALLEY

As we are 'back to our roots' more than ever this year in the Ozorian Valley, we'd like to highlight one of the many workshops you can visit, just one of the many ways you can tap into some ancient knowledge, connect with some of the roots, life philosophies of our humankind through creation and voice, with one of the oldest instruments of the world. At the 'Doromb' Workshop you can learn and try yourself at making your own mouth harp. Then you can learn to play your instrument alone or together with others, and alongside other acoustic instruments even, and experience the power of ancient mystery.

Ancient legend has it that the three Parcae or the sister Fates created the God of Divine Fire whose blacksmiths then forged our solar system, together with our visible world and all the planets. This way they formed the nature and characteristics of every planet within the solar system, and of the Sun itself.

One of the Parcae, who together in essence represent the mother-creators of all life, comes up with the idea, the thought of creation, and another spins the thread of life. That is how the analogy of string and vibration-based creation is born – the fabric of life. As cosmic fabric, these vibrations, energy waves and strings induce vibrations in us that connect to our chakras and direct how our bodies, souls and minds function.

The soul bird and the mother's womb are both reflected in the shape of the 'doromb', which, as a spiritual tool, portrays the mysteries of the creation of life. The classic 'doromb' shape is globally 90% the same in all ancient cultures. While creating, the blacksmith, the Man, opens the Woman, the 'doromb' up to his vibrations like a womb. By plucking the mouth harp, the seed at the end of the twanger acts like creative force, the mind, the vibrations densify, we hear its sound, it is born and we give life to noble thoughts, intent and actions. As the 'doromb' is a life-giving force, it specifically has a healing effect on its user. Its vibrations transform the low-resonance, decadent states of mind, elevate them, harmonizing body, soul and mind.

Tell us about your best road trip to O.Z.O.R.A.!

My best road trip was this year, because I wasn't stopped by the police for the first time in 4 years. Hahaha! But we had the best road trips here - at the festival. The trip to O.Z.O.R.A. is nothing compared to the rides with our small bikes here. When I go to get water everybody is looking at me because when I focus on driving I think I look very serious on a very ridiculous vehicle. This is quite funny!

Please introduce your little tribe!

All good friends – actually, I met some of them here at O.Z.O.R.A., 2012 I think.

How long does it take to set it up and down?

It's constantly growing, so it's hard to say how long it takes. It's still evolving. This tent was actually a wedding tent. In the last years (since 2012), we had some difficulties to set it up, but now we have enough experience with it, so it takes about an hour. But then somebody sits here and suddenly has a vision to put something somewhere. So, you can never say it's finished.

Newest item: The coffee maker.

Oldest item: The camper or the van. They are both from the seventies. It's a tie, I think!

Most useful item: A lighter in a lighter leash above the table. If everybody had to vote, it would be that. This is what we use the most, so it's the most useful, I think.

Prettiest item: I would say the red bus.

Most beloved item: It's the bus too because that's where the music comes from. But not everybody would agree with it, I guess! Hahaha.

Must have: A lighter and a knife.

Pain in the ass: Mosquitos. And when some people want to sleep and the others are just arriving from the dancefloor and want to listen to some music. And my friend would probably say it's the kids at festivals issue. But I'm not sure. I say it's not just black or white. I'm not sure that I would bring my child here, but I don't want to say it's bad. If you can watch over them, then it's fine.

How do you beat the weather?

I think like everybody. When it's raining, we come under the tent.

What is your ultimate camping advice?

If you take everything into account, I would say: start small. Hahaha.

What do you think about the Ozorian campsite?

Oooh, it's great. The festival is more expensive now than it was 4-5 years ago, but I don't mind to pay a 100 euros more, if they do something useful with the money. Some people say it's getting more commercial with the growing process, but I think it is not a problem, if it works. And it does.

One problem is that most of the security guards don't speak English. It can be dangerous, if somebody needs help. There is room for improvement regarding communication... In the beginning, they are all a little tense, but time and all the freakiness here makes them softer, I think.

What is your next destination?

Home again and then surfing in Portugal.

What is your non-music program tip at O.Z.O.R.A?

Oooh, there's so many other things to do, then workshops. Or not to do! Hahaha! I've been here 5 times now, but I've never actually joined a workshop. But I look at them when I'm showing the festival to new visitors.

COOKING GROOVE

VIKKE LEPORISZ

LET'S HEAR VIKKE LEPORISZ, GEOGRAPHER AND SEASONED TRAVELLER ABOUT AN INDIAN SNACK THAT EVERYONE KNOWS, OR SHOULD KNOW. IT IS THE POGÁCSA OF THE INDIAN SUBCONTINENT — MADE DIFFERENTLY BY EVERY HOUSEHOLD, BUT WITH JUST A LITTLE MORE OOMPH FROM THE SPICES.

'These triangular deep-fried pastries, usually with spicy potato and peas filling are an iconic Indian snack, which you can find everywhere in the country for 5-15 rupees each. You can find young teenagers helping their family business and making the dough at the open shops of Delhi, Mumbai or Chennai and also it's an ultimate snack of the bus stations and train stations of the Subcontinent. You can meet one of the samosawallas in the trains shouting "Garam Samose, garam samose khaaie" (Hot Samosa! Let's eat hot samosas!) and in this way you can try different kinds from different parts of the country. Let's learn to make this easy and popular food, taste Indian spices and be part of the whole process."

The filling is based on a pre-made mixture of potatoes and spices, but you can add greenpeas, chickpeas, carrots, peanuts, or whatever you want. We are going to use good Hungarian potatoes and greenpeas alongside with fresh Indian spices.'



RECIPE: SAMOSAS

FOR 3-4 PERSONS:

THE PASTRY:

- 2 CUPS OF MAIDA OR ALL PURPOSE FLOUR
- 4 TABLESPOONS OF OIL OR GHEE
- 5-6 TABLESPOONS OF WATER
- SALT AS REQUIRED
- OIL FOR DEEP FRYING

THE FILLING:

- 3-4 MEDIUM SIZED POTATOES
- 1 CUP OF GREEN PEAS (FRESH OR FROZEN)
- 1-2 (OR MANY) GREEN CHILLIES
- 2-3 CM OF GINGER
- CUMIN SEEDS

WHOLE SPICES TO BE GROUND: SMALL PIECE OF CINNAMON, BLACK PEPPERS, CUMIN, CARDAMOM, CLOVE, CORIANDER SEEDS, ETC., OR AS YOUR FANTASY DECIDES.

PREPARING THE PASTRY:

- TAKE THE FLOUR AND SALT IN A BOWL, MIX WELL, THEN ADD THE OIL OR GHEE.

 WITH YOUR FINGERTIPS RUB THE OIL/GHEE IN THE FLOUR TO GET A BREADCRUMB-LIKE

 CONSISTENCY, THE WHOLE MIXTURE SHOULD CLAMP TOGETHER WHEN JOINED.
- FIRST ADD 1 OR 2 TBSP OF WATER AND BEGIN TO KNEAD ADDING WATER AS REQUIRED.

 THEN KNEAD TO A FIRM DOUGH. WHEN IT IS READY, COVER THE DOUGH WITH A NAPKIN AND KEEP ASIDE FOR 30-40 MINUTES.

PREPARING THE STUFFING:

- BOIL THE POTATOES AND PEAS TILL COOKED COMPLETELY, THEN PEEL THE POTATOES AND CHOP THEM INTO SMALL CUBES.
- DRY ROAST ALL THE WHOLE SPICES ABOVE TILL FRAGRANT. GRIND THEM IN A DRY GRINDER TO A FINE POWDER.
- HEAT OIL IN A PAN AND ADD THE CUMIN SEEDS UNTIL THEY CRACKLE.

OFF THE MAP

NOTHING NEW UNDER THE SUN

Today, we really go off the map. We talk to graphic artist Attila Balogh who painted Sezlon, the subtly psychedelic van belonging to the deco team that roams the Valley on its mission to bring you visual delicacies.

'Do you have an idea of what you will paint beforehand, or you let your hand lead you?'

'In a large amount of cases, it comes naturally, by itself. Sometimes I draw sketches beforehand, so that the person who ordered it can also see it. But the result is always the best when they give you a free hand, when you can do whatever you want.'

'You may never know anything in advance, sorry for barking into it,' says a voice, that of Mtrixxism, head of arts and deco at O.Z.O.R.A. who is sitting at the table, the only quiet place for the interview with her morning coffee in her sunglasses. Attila is her discovery, and he says his life had been turned around "180 percent" after coming here to work last year. She keeps on interupting, while Attila talks; imagine a voice with a before-the-morning-coffee bite to it, that cuts no bullsh.t. But it's Attila who does most of the talking.

'When I arrived here this year, I just looked right, and I said: 'Hmm, how great that grean van is.' Then, I received permission to paint one of them, and got this VW Transporter. I painted the wish of Márti (Trixxx) onto the appropriate part of the van.'

'What was the demand before the project?'

'It is funny because there was a contrast between me and the project. The job was to paint something Ozora compatible. And cute. And I am a graffiti artist and a rocker, so... (laughs). Anyhow, I was moved by the drive to make it Ozorian. To have the visual forms and visuality of this year's poster be reflected in it.'

'You are left-handed and can also paint with both hands.'

'Yeah. I can only recommend to anyone to start using both hands synchroniously because that will bring synchronicity and you will be much more balanced. 'The jugglers too.'

'I heard when I was walking around the Valley, in every language how amazing the van was, wow, stunning, jaw-dropping... all kinds of words. Márti jumped out of her skin when she saw it.'

'And took it away when it got ready. The two other fellas who use the van just looked on sadly. They thought we will take it for a first spin together. 'Yeah right, I got to go' and off I was, haha.' – interjects Márti, happier now with coffee in hand.

I heard in many languages how super, fantastic, fenomenal, incredibly crazy it was.

'We kept yanking it away from him (laughs).'

'Yeah I couldn't paint it properly because they always took it for a spin. I also got a commission to do another bus for someone here already.'

'And we have to say that I found Attila and he helps a lot.'

'Yeah, for me, O.Z.O.R.A. was a 180 degree turn in my life. When I arrived for the first time, I was here but I didn't fit into it. Like trying to push a globe into a cube.'

'So much so that last year your nearly exploded.'
