
FROM A SMALL SEED A MIGHTY TRUNK MAY GROW...

The Psychonaut: Re-Thinking The Human In Times Of Crisis

THROUGHOUT HISTORY HUMAN BEINGS HAVE USED PSYCHO-**ACTIVE SUBSTANCES TO ALTER** THEIR CONSCIOUSNESS. FROM AYAHUASCA DRINKING SHAMANS IN THE AMAZON, KHAT CHEWING ELDERS IN KENYA, AND HASH-ISH SMOKING SADHUS IN INDIA, **HUMANS HAVE EXPLORED THESE** SUBSTANCES' UNIQUE ACTIVE PROPERTIES ON THE HUMAN MIND. PSYCHONAUTS - NAVIGATORS OF THE HUMAN PSYCHE - HAVE DRAWN ON THESE SUBSTANCES TO EXPLORE THE EXPERIENTIAL LIMITS OF THE HUMAN MIND AND BODY, AND ENCOUNTER ALTERNATIVE POSSIBILITIES OF HUMAN BEING WHICH DEMAND THE ARTICULATION

IN TIMES OF GLOBAL ECOLOGICAL. ECONOMIC, AND POLITICAL CRISIS, THESE CONCEPTUAL CHALLENGES MAY OFFER NEW WAYS IN WHICH TO THINK ABOUT AND ORGANISE SOCIETY ON A GLOBAL SCALE. THE PSYCHONAUT (FROM THE

GREEK PSYCHE - MIND/SOUL. AND NAUT - SAILOR/EXPLORER) IS AN EXPLORER OF UNKNOWN TERRITORIES OF THE PSYCHE IN ALTERED STATES OF CONSCIOUS-NESS. PSYCHONAUTS DEPLOY PSYCHOACTIVE SUBSTANCES AS TOOLS OR CHEMICAL DEVICES TO NAVIGATE NEW EXISTENTIAL TERRITORIES WITHIN THE POSSIBIL-ITIES OF HUMAN EXPERIENCE. THE ENGAGEMENT WITH UNFAMILIAR FORMS OF HUMAN EXPERIENCES WHICH CANNOT BE ACCOUNTED FOR BY DOMINANT EXPLANATORY SCHEMES UNSETTLE ONTOLOGICAL FRAMEWORKS, DEMANDING

PSYCHONAUTS SEEK OUT THE NOVEL AND THE UNKNOWN — AS PARTICULAR SUBSTANCES MAY LEAD TO PREDICTABLE RESULTS, POLY-SUBSTANCE COMBINATION AND HEROIC DOSAGES (LEARY 1980) ENSURE THESE EXPERIENCES ARE CAPABLE OF REPEATEDLY CUTTING OPEN ONTOLOGICAL HORIZONS, PERPETUALLY RUPTURING THE FRACTAL FABRIC OF THE REAL, AND OF THE POSSIBLE. PSYCHONAUTS IN THIS SENSE ARE "EDGEWORKERS" (LYNG 2005), WHO SEEK LIMIT-EXPERIENCES WHICH PUSH THE HUMAN MIND AND BODY TO THE EDGE OF

ITS PHYSICAL CAPABILITIES, TO THE EDGE
OF THE POSSIBLE OR THE KNOWN. HERE,
ON "THE EDGE", THE COSMOLOGICAL
FRAMEWORK WHICH DEFINES THE HORIZON
OF POSSIBILITY IS PUSHED TO BREAKING
POINT, AND SOMETIMES SURPASSED,
CREATING A NEW FRAMEWORK WHICH CAN
ACCOMMODATE NEW EMPIRICAL POSSIBIL-

THE PSYCHONAUT'S HUMAN-CHEMICAL ASSEMBLAGE IS A PARTICULAR FORM OF LIVING CYBORG, A TEMPORARY TRANSFORMATION OF THE HUMAN THROUGH A SYMBIOSIS WITH CHEMICAL TECHNOLOGIES. A NEW CORPOREAL SUBJECT IS CREATED, BOTH THROUGH THE TRANSFORMATIONS IN THE POSSIBILITIES OF PERCEPTION AND ACTION CAPACITATED BY THE CHEMICAL SUBSTANCES THEM-SELVES, BUT ALSO IN THE AUTONOMY OF RE-APPROPRIATING ONE'S OWN SUBJECTIV-ITY. AS SUCH, PSYCHONAUTS UTILISE THE CHEMICAL TECHNOLOGIES OF CAPITALISM TO EMANCIPATE THEMSELVES FROM IT, PRO-DUCING BODIES WHOSE VERY EXISTENCE SUBVERTS CAPITALIST HEGEMONY

"ENTHEOGENIC NEO-SHAMANISM ... IS (OR

COULD BE) OUR SOURCE OF POWER." (BEY 1985).

THE USE OF PSYCHOACTIVE SUBSTANC-ES TO INVESTIGATE THE POSSIBILITIES OF HUMAN EXPERIENCE LEADS US TO ARTICULATE OF A CONCEPT OF HUMANITY AND COSMOS THAT IS FLUID AND OPEN TO RUPTURE. Chambok House is the third eye chakra of O.Z.O.R.A., hands down. It has really come into its own during the past years and offers an excellent selection of lecturers – just a quick leafing through this year's programme is proof enough. The journey around our mind starts with Ancient Traditions today as we look into the role of trance and altered states in various traditions, especially the Vedic traditions. The roundtable discussion promises to be especially exciting on altered states and spiritual technologies. Then, the whole next day, Wednesday, we delve into psychedelic awareness. Thursday sees us entering the world of love and its various forms, take for example the lecture Pleasure As Medicine at 14:45, held by Caro Ophis. Friday is about entheogenics, the cue is The Power of Visions: from Ancient Greece to the Silicon Valley by Ede Frecska at 13:30 and on Friday, the talk is on musical (r)evolution, and day six is about Science and Spirituality, the pinnacle of it all, where rationality and intuition, the two brain halves meet and greet.

Meditation. Chambok also centers on letting go of all mental constructs, an essential step on the path of spiritual awakening and necessary as a break. Every day at 12:00, during the sound healing concert, kick back, sit or lie down. Turn off your mind and float downstream. It is not duing

Zoom in to see the bigger picture? Why not, and at the Microcosmos, with its microscopes zoning in on the wonders of the miniature world, do just that. There are lectures

every day at 17:00 that offer a deeper understanding of the god of small things. Let your mind be tickled in other ways. Few people know this, but learning a choreography or intricate movements like juggling can align the two brain halves and work unknown places of your brain. Go to the Psyrcus every day between 12:00 and 14:00 where you can tune those fine motoric skills: juggling, slackline, dancing choreographies. At the Pyramid, yoga and movement art form courses are offered every day from morning till evening. The Wheel of Wisdom, through a complex, seven-day programme will offer an understanding of the various levels of consciousness. OUR DAILY BREAD - RAWSOME

Somehow, we have only featured one raw recipe on these pages since starting this column, but now we are paying our due. Raw, of course, is uncooked, unadulterated nature at its best. Gabriella Mihalik has been creating her Rawmazing Cakes for years now at the festival. So let's hear from her, today, on her first of two workshops at the Cooking Groove this week.

Raw food creation gives a rest to cooking stoves while inviting you to a wide range for experimentation. We will make raw cakes that are made by combining various layers of seeds, raw cacao, fresh fruits and Ozorian green leaves. They will all be vegan and gluten-free. In this series of three workshops we will make a different raw cake each time. 3 workshops, each 2 hours long – 1 hour for making, 1 hour for cooling.

Gabriella will show you three kinds of cakes: Rawmazing Choc-Brownie-Mint Cake, Lavender Cheesecake, and a Peach-Berry-Chia Cake. Rawsome!

RECIPE:

JUGGLING

THE ART OF CONTROLLING PATTERNS IN TIME AND SPACE

PYROPOCOK, DIRECTOR OF CIRCUS ARTS IN THE VALLEY, HAS SOME SERIOUS JUGGLING TO DO TO KEEP ALL THE CIRCUS-RELATED PROGRAMS FLOWING SMOOTHLY DURING THE FESTIVAL, BUT ABOUT JUGGLING HE SIMPLY SAYS:

JUGGLING IS WHEN YOU KEEP 3 OR MORE OBJECTS IN THE AIR AT ONE TIME WITH AN ALTERNATING TOSS-UP AND CATCH TECHNIQUE. THE MOST OFTEN USED PROPS INCLUDE BALLS, CLUBS, RINGS, CIGAR BOXES, WHILE THE CON-TEMPORARY JUGGLING WORLD ALSO USES DIABOLO, DEVIL STICKS, POI AND FIRE-SPINNING PROPS TO MAKE THIS CIRCUS ART FORM EVEN MORE DRAMATIC, OR CHALLENGING. TO CATCH SOME TRUE MASTERS OF JUGGLING AND OBJECT MANIPULATION AT THEIR BEST, COME TO THE CIRCUS EVERY EVENING FROM 9 PM.

RONALD GRAHAM, ONE OF THE GREATEST MATHEMATICIANS

ALIVE, THE GUY WHOSE LICENSE PLATE READS NUMBER AND WHO INVENTED THE GREATEST NUMBER EVER, IS ALSO CONSIDERED TO BE ONE OF THE PRINCIPAL ARCHI-TECTS OF THE RAPID DEVELOP-MENT WORLDWIDE OF DISCRETE MATHEMATICS IN RECENT YEARS. THE EARLIEST RECORD OF
JUGGLING DATES BACK TO A
15TH CENTURY BC TOMB OF AN
UNKNOWN EGYPTIAN PRINCE
SHOWING FEMALE DANCERS AND
ACROBATS THROWING BALLS, BUT
IT HAS ROOTS IN MANY OTHER
EARLY CULTURES ALL AROUND
THE WORLD, FROM CHINESE,

INDIAN THROUGH GREEK, ROMAN AND AZTEC, POLYNESIAN, AND EVEN NORSE. IN ANCIENT CHINA, FOR EXAMPLE, JUGGLING WAS **EVEN PERFORMED BY WARRIORS** AS AN ART OF SPECIAL SKILL AND POWER. LEGEND HAS IT THAT THE CHINESE EVEN WON A BATTLE BECAUSE THE ENEMY TROOPS FLED WITHOUT FIGHTING AFTER SEEING FAMOUS CHU WARRIOR. XIONG YILIAO, JUGGLING NINE BALLS ADVANCING ON THEM ON THE BATTLEFIELD AT THE HEAD OF HIS ARMY. NOT SURPRISINGLY, JUGGLING BECAME LESS POPULAR IN THE DARKLY RELIGIOUS EU-ROPEAN MIDDLE AGES BECAUSE JUGGLERS, CALLED 'GLEEMEN' AT THE TIME, WERE ACCUSED OF BAD MORALS AND EVEN WITCHCRAFT. JUGGLERS BECAME THE PER-FORMERS OF DRINKING HOUSES. MARKETPLACES AND FAIRS, UP UNTIL THE BIRTH OF THE MODERN CIRCUS, OPENED BY ONE PHILIP ASTLEY IN 1768, WHO EMPLOYED JUGGLERS TO PERFORM ALONG-SIDE HORSE AND CLOWN ACTS. THIS IS HOW JUGGLING BECAME ONE OF THE PILLARS OF CIRCUS ARTS.

TUESDAY - SIMON, MAEVA, TYMO AND DAWID

The Cooking Grove is a perfect place for making friends. There is a lot of shade and everyone is more relaxed from all the delicious smells filling the air. Here it is also true what they say, that the best parties are always in the kitchen. This is also where the merry group of friends came together who I chose as the subjects of my article today. Simon and Maeva, a really nice French couple, were just getting ready to cook when Tymo and Dawid, two good Polish mates, sat down to the table next to them. They started talking and by the time I reached them, they were already cooking lunch together. Simon and Maeva are

vegan and though the other two love meat dishes, they were satisfied with the smells of the cooking vegan meal.

RED LENTIL VEGETABLE STEW

Ingredients for 4 people

400 g of red lentil
1 onion
3 cloves of garlic
3 tomatoes
1 small zucchini
2-3 spoons of oil
Salt and curry to taste
Serve with fresh
chopped chives

PREPARATION

Peel the onion and thinly slice it. Dice the tomato and the zucchini. Peel and finely chop the

garlic. Caramelize the onion on a little oil and then throw in the diced veggies and the chpped garlic. Then add the salt and curry, wait until the zucchini is semi-cooked in the juice of the tomatoes. This is when you add the red lentils and add enough water to just about cover them. By the time the water boils away, the red lentils will be cooked soft. When the stew was ready, Simon sprinkled it with fresh chives from the Cooking Grove kitchen garden. The green color looked good on it too and the taste of chives also went really well with it. This dish is a vegan masterpiece.

recycling, healing, spirituality. In addition, there are also talk shows about literature, sciences, which include Spoken Beats, Chambokology, StreamPunk Radio Show, Alternate Remedies.

A very important element of the overall concept is to offer daily music content, mixes, made exclusively for our radio, many times also paired with interviews. Besides broadcasting exclusive musical content, streaming our One Day In parties and especially the festival live is also a top priority. This will be the third year that listeners can hear live sets from all stages, as well as live interviews, check-ins from the site. You can tune in online any time, catch some of the vibes even if you could not make it, or are still on your way here, but you can also catch the radio station on FM 91.6 once you're here. The core crew, otherwise, consists of only

three people, but there are quite many contributors with 2-weekly or monthly series. I am responsible for keeping in touch with the artists playing on the radio, I organize and put together the musical content. The two other members of our small crew are our reporter, who does 90% of the interviews, from the festival and beyond, and my editor colleague. The two of them also make up the spine of our online newspaper, The Ozorian Prophet, which comes out daily in hard copy print during the festival, handed out all around. Our IT guru and graphic designer also contribute a lot to our common cause. We got the most positive feedback in connection with our music-related interviews. We are really proud to be able to 'fill a gap' and bring the artists closer to you, give an even more personal 'voice' to their music, and also exemplify how the radio is still very much alive and kicking, bringing our scene's protagonists closer home, wherever you are. Our oldest series, In Focus has presented more than 200 artists so far, while we also have regular Before Party sessions, live and direct from the studio, with international artists who're gigging in Budapest and drop in, and our On the Way to O.Z.O.R.A. editions, running for 3 years now, also usually start with friendly conversations. And what truly shows that stuff of dreams, in this case radiOzora and building a community, can take root and flourish on good vibes is that 'almost everyone' has joined till now, more than 50 record labels, crews or individual artists have official ongoing shows on the wavelengths.
